History

- Special Olympics World Games 2023 in Berlin
- No known program for Special Athletes

Clubs

- national gymnastics federation → no program for Special Athletes or Para-Gymnastics
- national SpecialOlympics → real development of gymnastics started after 2023
- all are specialised in something, but weren't aware of Special or Para Athletes in Gymnastics

Politics

- local clubs normally follow what the national clubs provide
- new things need to be developed in local clubs and then made bigger until national club is interested
- a lot of personal effort needed for development

History

- at least 50 years experience in inclusion of Special Athletes
- big competitions include Special Athletes (e.g. 2000 participants and 150 Special Athletes)
- Cindy has her own Gym where a lot Special Athletes train
- Cindy one of the main persons behind development of SpecialOlympics gymnastics program and now also of the Para-Gymnastics program
